Waste collected at irregular intervals.




Fire in dump yards due to combustible materials present in waste

The program is being implemented in Community Public Private Partnership Model

The project strengthens the solid waste management of the Panchayat to solve community concerns

The project duration is for 5 years.

The project is developed in self – sustainability model, after the completion it can continue its function.



Role of Resource Recovery Centre-Re cyclable Materials



- Avg. One Tonnes of Recyclable waste/per day is being effectively collected and segregated.
- 8 Category of Segregation is being done
- Plastic shredder is used to shred plastic waste which is used in laying of plastic roads.
- The non-recyclable plastic waste are bailed and send for coprocessing.

Role of Resource Recovery Centre-Organic







- The resource centre handles avg. 2 tonnes of Organic waste/per day effectively
- Organic Compost & Vermin Compost are manufactured in the Resource Centre
- Vegetable garden is created to check the nutrients of the compost.

Segregated Combustible Fraction (SCF) as Alternate Fuel




- Co-processing of non-recyclable SCF as alternative fuel.
- Replacing usage of fossil fuels.
- Effective way of disposing waste that was a cause of concern hitherto.
- A locally viable, environmentally & economically sound waste disposal alternative

Creating Dignity in Work





- 55 SHG women from local community are trained to implement this initiative.
- We have named our garbage collectors as "Green Friends"
- They collect the garbage from the house and do the source segregation.
- They are involved in maintain the compost yard.
- The green friends are provided with uniforms, identity cards, personal protective equipments.
- They are also involved in awareness and campaign programs.

Avg.Monthly Income- Rs.4,000/-



Impact of Clean & Green Madukkarai





- 100% Door to Door collection of domestic waste
- Clean Streets
- Planted over 3000 trees
- Leveraged Rs.1 Crore for Solid Waste Management from various Govt.Schemes
- 25% Reduction in water & air borne disease in Panchayat.
- No blockage in drains.
- Zero Landfill Panchayat
- More than 5000 students have been trained in Solid Waste Management Principles.
